Our facilities:

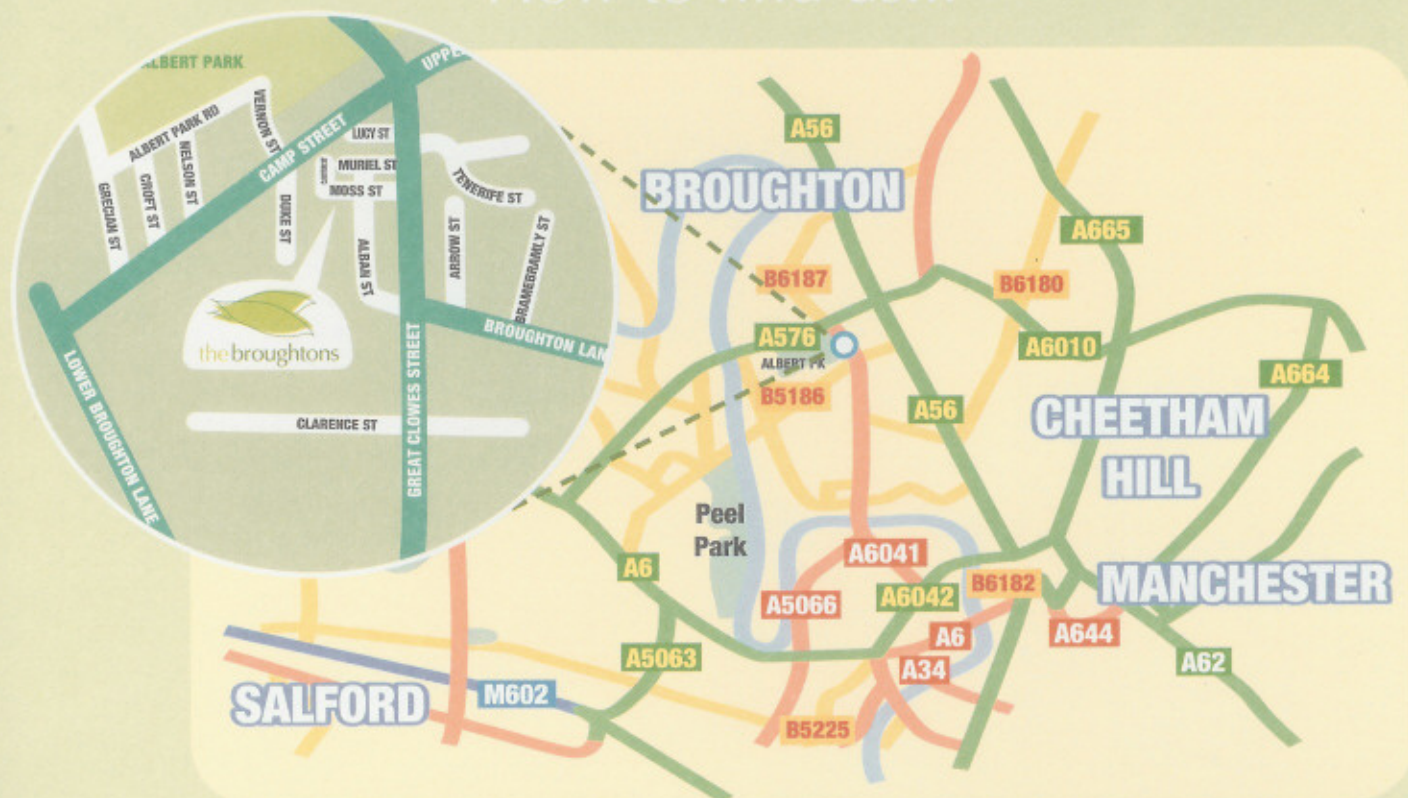
- 35 single rooms and a companion room, most with en-suite
