Policy Statement

Wellbeing Residential Group believes that all Residents should have the freedom to visit family and friends to keep their social life active. Wellbeing Residential cares for the Safety and Wellbeing of their residents therefore staff and management use a Service user daily care log and visitors book to keep check on the whereabouts of residents.

Wellbeing Residential also highlights Residents' absences /visits in handovers to let all staff know where all residents are. Residents are asked to let staff know when leaving the building and give an approximate time of returning to the home.

Wellbeing Residential provides assistance to residents who obtain difficulty when being alone. The home provides assistance in the terms of wheelchairs, walking sticks, walking frames, equipment that will fulfil the resident's needs. Wellbeing Residential also provides assistance upon a resident's request of someone physically supporting them and being present at their side.
